## GAME DAYS - SEASONALLY BETWEEN 10 AND 20 HOURS PER WEEK

- Set up and pack up tent
- Set up and pack up lollies, drinks, snacks as required
- Sell these items, collect cash and retain for hand over to Director
- Ensure the amenities (toilet) building is unlocked
- Sign in all players
- Respond to player inquiries
- Ensure teams have bibs and a ball
- Ensure games are timed correctly
- Issue and collect score cards
- Register players who 'turn up' unexpectedly
- Collect casual player fees
- Enter scores into game duty report as they come in
- Check sign in sheets for unregistered players
- Respond to Facebook comments regarding wet weather
- Respond to PM Messages via Facebook regarding games and wet weather
- Full responsibility for managing wet weather cancellations
- Post images and video to Facebook and Instagram from time to time
- Build a strong relationship with the Directors and Umpires Convenor
